The California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC) is the singular general education pathway for California Community College (CCC) students to fulfill lower-division general education requirements necessary for transfer and admission to both the California State University (CSU) and the University of California (UC). The Cal-GETC replaces both IGETC and CSU GE for all community college transfer students who begin college in Fall 2025 or after.

Students who need Cal GETC:

- Students matriculating to IVC Fall 2025 and after. Dual Enrollment high school students do not earn catalog rights.
- Students returning to IVC Fall 2025 and beyond who lost previous catalog rights.

Students who do not need Cal GETC:

- Students with continuous enrollment prior to Fall 2025 may remain on the CSU GE or IGETC patterns.
- Students who have earned a prior full CSU GE or IGETC certification do not need to complete the Cal-GETC for university admission. Previous CSU GE and IGETC certifications will continue to be accepted by both the CSU and UC systems.
- Students with official transcripts showing conferral of an Associate Degree for Transfer are not required to complete Cal GETC.

Cal GETC Applicable Coursework:

- Cal GETC effective dates begin Fall 2025 or later. IGETC approval dates can be used only if the course
 has a corresponding Cal GETC approval. If the course has no Cal GETC approval, the IGETC approval cannot be used.
- Courses can be accepted from the 6 US regionally accredited institutions.
- The Cal GETC will accept AP and IB external examinations. No AP for areas 1B or 1C. CLEP is not accepted.
- A minimum grade of "C" or higher is required for all courses used for Cal GETC certification. Pass/No Pass
 is acceptable provided a "Pass" is equivalent to a "C" or higher. No more than 14 units of Pass/No Pass is
 accepted by the UC System or for Cal GETC.
- C- graded at a value less than 2.0 cannot be used on Cal GETC.

Certification:

- Only full certification is available. No partial or subject area credit is available.
- Certification must be requested by the student.

Requirements Outside of Cal GETC - CCC Can Certify

- CSU: U.S. History, Constitution and American Ideals- (American Institutions) Requirement
- UC: Language Other Than English (LOTE)
